REGULAR BOARD MEETING

March 14, 2022

The Board of Commissioners of Bayou Cane Fire Protection District of the Parish of Terrebonne, State of Louisiana, met on Monday, March 14, 2022, at 11:30 a.m.

Robert Page called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m. Upon roll call by Ms. Kay Hebert, the following Commissioners were present: Hayward Sims, Robert Page, Travis Gravois and Ed Lawson. The following Commissioners were absent: Nicholas Hebert, Suzanne Carlos and Jacob Rhodes. Others in attendance were Chief Himel, Chief Hill, Mike Delaune, Mike Palmer, Greg Boudreaux, Nathan Allen, Cody Hebert, Ethan Adams, Tim Guidry, Patti Floyd, Kay Hebert and Taylor Gravois and Suzanne Settoon with CSRS.

It was motioned by Ed Lawson, seconded by Travis Gravois to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of February 14, 2022. Motion passed.

No one from the Public addressed the Board.

It was motioned by Ed Lawson, seconded by Hayward Sims to send a letter to Nicholls regarding the position for the Civil Service Board. Motion passed.

Chief Himel introduced Taylor Gravois and Suzanne Settoon with CSRS to the board. They were present to give an update on the FEMA claim. Taylor discussed the expenses incurred prior to the storm and the damages. Chief Hill discussed the station damages, insurance coverage and building code. They also discussed revenue loss due to Hurricane Ida and Hazard Mitigation funding available.

It was motioned by Ed Lawson, seconded by Travis Gravois to give the department authorization to move forward with the application process for the Community Disaster Loan. Motion passed.

Chief Himel discussed the Fire Chief's report. There were 152 incidents in February and 377 YTD incidents. 29 smoke detectors were installed in February. There were three active fire investigations in the month of February. Chief acknowledged his fireman for providing supplies to the family that lost nearly everything in a camper fire.

It was motioned by Travis Gravois, seconded by Ed Lawson to approve the February financials. Motion passed.

Ed Lawson thanked the staff for a job well done and encouraged safety. Robert Page acknowledged the pride of the district that resonates to the community and also encouraged safety.
