REGULAR BOARD MEETING

March 13, 2023

The Board of Commissioners of Bayou Cane Fire Protection District of the Parish of Terrebonne, State of Louisiana, met on Monday, March 13, 2023, at 11:30 a.m.

Robert Page called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m. Upon roll call by Sonja Labat, the following Commissioners were present: Robert Page, Suzanne Carlos, Hayward Sims, Travis Gravois, Ed Lawson and Jacob Rhodes. It was motioned by Ed Lawson, seconded by Jacob Rhodes to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of February 13, 2023. Motion passed.

No one from the Public addressed the Board.

Chief Himel discussed EMS billing. It was motioned by Ed Lawson, seconded by Jacob Rhodes to hire Insight for the EMS billing. Motion passed.

Chief Himel discussed the Intergovernmental Agreement with Terrebonne Communications District (E911) for Emergency Medical Dispatching. The contract was approved by legal. The contract totals \$79,793 which includes \$44,000 for dispatch and maintenance fees and \$35,793 for a one time software update. It was motioned by Ed Lawson, seconded by Travis Gravois to authorize the Chairman to execute the contract. Motion passed.

Chief Himel discussed the Fire Chief's report. There were four new permit requests and three major communication renovations. The old Twin Peaks building will be torn down and Aldi will be built soon. There were nine smoke alarms installed. There were 165 calls in February and 348 year to date calls. The first ambulance is currently in Harvey. Tower 1 and Truck 22 are back in service. The staff is gathering information for a new truck and is estimated to cost \$750,000. The FEMA repairs on the classroom are almost complete. The maintenance building and Station 4 are in permitting and will be repaired next. The staff is still waiting to hear the status of the radio grant. The Safer Grant which will fund nine employees will be submitted soon. Applications will be taken on April 6th for the Firehouse grant. The staff is looking into fire prevention and safety grant opportunities.
